As agency staff are not directly employed by the Council, it does not have a statutory responsibility to report on the number of agency staff engaged as it needs to for staff
who it directly employs and pays via the payroll system. Furthermore, the responsibility for the engagement of agency staff is devolved to the service area and there is consequently no central record of numbers of agency staff engaged that can be easily interrogated. The information requested may only be established through a detailed review of invoices relating to agency expenditure. This work is underway and I will endeavour to provide a verbal update at the Council meeting.
