Background

Further to the report presented to Committee in July for additional restrictions in St John's Ward, St Mary's and St David's within Wards have now also been reviewed

Brecon Town Review Phase 2 St Mary's Ward

The majority of complaints within St Marys ward were for Cerrigcochion Road. The northbound side had extensive restrictions introduced during the initial review, which caused the parking to migrate to the southbound side. This has created access problems for the hospital, and causes congestion for southbound traffic at peak times. Additionally vehicles parked adjacent to the junctions on the side streets are also an issue. There have also been complaints received regarding parking at the junction in Camden Road and Little Free Street, and of inconsiderate parking adjacent to Eyrie Oakes. The review carried out with the Ward member, considered the complaints, and it was agreed that additional restrictions were appropriate. These are indicated on the enclosed plans.

Brecon Town Review Phase 2 St David Within Wards

Following the July Committee, concerns were raised regarding parking on the approach to Duckhams Yard Car Park. Vehicles are being parked all day causing visibility issues at the junction of Silver Street, and access issues to the properties fronting Orchard Street. A review was carried out with the Ward Member and it was considered appropriate to introduce restrictions its length with a small additional section on Silver Street. These are indicated on the enclosed plans

The review for all three Wards with Brecon have now been completed and they will be ranked and added to the list.
