As a result of the purchase of unit 23, Ffrwdgrech Estate Brecon being delayed to late January 2017 due to legal concerns over the vendor's title to part of the land included for sale (being essential parking for the occupiers of the unit after refurbishment), it has not been possible to spend all of the allocated budget during this financial year.

An initial budget of £380,000 was created to fund the purchase of the property (£275,000 plus Stamp Duty Land Tax and legal fees), with the residual budget to be used to progress an initial refurbishment and conversion programme to divide the property into up to 6 new business workshops.

Although initial scoping meetings have been held with the Professional Lead – Projects and Planned Maintenance, it has not been possible for the work to be tendered due to the delays in purchase outlined above.

A request is therefore made to vire the residual budget of £100,000 into the new 2017/18 financial year to enable the refurbishment programme to commence as soon as possible with the end result of new Council-owned business units being offered to the Brecon area for the first time.
