**Summary**

Following the initial parking review in Brecon Town Centre, a second review was carried out and members gave approval to advertise the new proposals and implement provided no substantive objections were received.

The proposals were ranked and placed within the list of reviews to be implemented.

However, there is a new development proposed, that is accessed from Cerrigcochion Road, and the proposals that were approved by Committee have been revisited due to the expected increase in traffic along Cerrigcochion Road. There is a proposed amendment, to remove the limited waiting and replace with prohibition of waiting at any time.

**Proposal**

It is proposed to remove the original proposed limited waiting and replace with a Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time restriction. This proposal is shown on the included plan.

**One Powys Plan**

Stronger, Safer & Economically Viable Communities – The proposal will help prevent the regularly occurring inconsiderate parking, whilst still allowing some on street parking in areas that won't cause obstruction to the free flow of traffic.

**Options Considered/Available**

Option 1 Over-rule the new proposal – This would mean PCC would advertise the original proposals. However, there would still be issues with congestion on Cerrigcochion Road.

Option 2 Support the new proposal – This would allow the new proposal to be advertised, and implemented if no substantive objections were received.

**Preferred Choice and Reasons**

The preferred choice would be Option 2. This will prevent congestion along Cerrigcochion Road which will be exacerbated by the new development.
