**SUBJECT:** Presteigne Safe Routes in Community Network

REPORT FOR: Decision / Discussion / Information

### **Summary**

Capital funding has been received for a safe routes in community network scheme within Presteigne.

The proposed scheme would create unsegregated shared use paths along routes to and from the local schools.

As part of the overall scheme it is proposed to install a toucan crossing on the bypass (B4355)

It is also proposed to introduce some parking restrictions along Slough Road to prevent the inconsiderate parking that causes congestion and creates a hazard to the vulnerable road users that would walk or cycle along this section of carriageway.

#### Proposal

It is proposed to introduce the parking restrictions along Slough Road. It is also proposed to install a formal toucan crossing at the desired crossing point on the bypass (B4355)

#### One Powys Plan

Stronger, Safer & Economically Viable Communities – The proposal will help prevent the regularly occurring inconsiderate parking and create safer routes and crossing points for the community, particularly the vulnerable road users travelling to and from school.

#### **Options Considered/Available**

Option 1 Over-rule the new proposal – this will prevent the safer routes to be completed.

Option 2 Support the new proposal – This would allow the new proposal to be advertised, and implemented if no substantive objections were received, and allow comprehensive safer routes to be completed.

### **Preferred Choice and Reasons**

The preferred choice would be Option 2. This will prevent inconsiderate parking and allow a safe crossing point along the safer routes.
