SUBJECT: Parking Review, Pontneddfechan, Tawe Uchaf

REPORT FOR: Decision / Discussion / Information

Summary

A parking review was carried out in the Tawe Uchaf Ward in March 2015. There were 3 separate areas reviewed, Coelbren, Caehopkin and Pontneddfechan. There were no objections received to the proposals in Coelbren and Caehopkin and these were implemented on 22 June 2015.

There was a number of objections received regarding the proposals in Pontneddfechan, and to alleviate the concerns raised PCC tried on numerous occasions to liaise with NPTBC to agree restrictions in their area that borders PCC, to give a more comprehensive scheme to manage the inconsiderate parking that regularly occurs in the village. Unfortunately support was not forthcoming from NPTBC, and as such, a lesser scheme within the PCC area, that takes into account all of the objections is recommended to be taken forward and implemented.

Proposal

It is proposed to reduce the original proposed Prohibition Of Waiting At Any Time restrictions. These proposals are shown on the included plan.

One Powys Plan

Stronger, Safer & Economically Viable Communities – The proposal will help prevent the regularly occurring inconsiderate parking, whilst still allowing some on street parking in areas that wont cause obstruction to the free flow of traffic.

Options Considered/Available

Option 1 Over-rule the objections – This would allow PCC to implement the original proposals. However, with the lack of support from NPTBC and the residents concerns, this would not be beneficial to the village as a whole.

Option 2 Uphold the objections – This would allow the reduced proposals to be implemented and allow a balance between reducing the inconsiderate parking and allowing some on street parking at preferred locations within the village.

Preferred Choice and Reasons

The preferred choice would be Option 2. This will provide some on street parking, whilst preventing inconsiderate parking along the narrow sections that can prevent access to the village for larger vehicles.
