## **REPORT FOR:** Information

- 1 On 20<sup>th</sup> January 2014 the Department for Communities and Local Government ("DCLG") issued the Local Government Pension Scheme (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2014 [SI 2014 No. 44) which comes into force on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2014. These regulations amend the the Local Government Pension Scheme (Benefits, Membership and Contributions) Regulations 2007 ("the Benefits Regulations"); the Local Government Pension Scheme (Administration) Regulations 2008 ("the Administration Regulations"); and, the Local Government Pension Scheme Regulations 2013 ("the 2013 Regulations").
- 2 The Benefits Regulations are amended to extend the categories of small payments that are authorised for commutation into one-off lump sums.
- 3 The Administration Regulations are amended to clarify the provisions relating to membership of the Scheme following the introduction of the employer duties for automatic enrolment and re-enrolment, in particular, affected eligible members with a contract of less than three months will have no barrier to automatic entry to the Scheme.
- 4 The 2013 Regulations are amended to provide that the Housing Ombudsman may participate in the LGPS.
