SUBJECT: Question from County Councillor Avril York

Builth Town Council, like many towns in Powys, host a range of non-statutory services. The Cabinet has already made it clear that they do not intend to continue to run toilets or play parks. In order for these towns to make logical & sensible decisions on behalf of their council tax payers about priorities they need information of the current costs of these provisions. Therefore why are the portfolio holder and Leader of the Cabinet unwilling to share the current cost of running the toilets on the Groe with the local member and the town council?

Detailed financial information will be provided to each town and community council regarding the toilet blocks in their area. There has been a substantial amount of work needed to prepare the information in the right amount of detail which has resulted in a slight delay.
