18.1 Question to the Portfolio Holder for Adult Social Care from County Councillor Gwilym Williams

The background to my question is regarding adult and social care, when a consultant drew up contracts and awarded them to four national large providers for people's care in their homes.

It came to my attention when these contracts were being awarded I was told that the consultant after he had finished his contracts and left Powys, was going to work for one of these providers.

At the beginning of 2014 when I was Chairman of the Radnorshire Committee when the portfolio holder Darren Mayor attended, I asked the question was the consultant going to work for one of these providers. They assured me and promised that this was not going to happen. It then came to light, confirmed by Darren Mayor, that the consultant was now working for one of these companies, therefore, is it ethical for this to happen?

I now understand there is to be an independent inquiry into how these contracts were awarded, and obviously we must wait the decision, but any inquiry will look at what has happened in the past, I would like to look to the future.

My question would be to the portfolio holder in light of the above can all consultants that award contracts for Powys County Council, and then leave the authority, be not allowed to work for these companies for at least one year after the contract was awarded?
