Homeless update 20th May 2020:

- Number of live homeless cases 275
- Number of homeless households in temporary accommodation excluding B & B's 96
- Number of households now in B & B 15
- Number of new properties identified to boost temporary accommodation 62
- Number of known rough sleepers 3
- Number of homeless presentations during the last two weeks 22
- Number of homeless presentations since 1st March 163(compared to 110 same period last year)
- Top reasons for homeless presentations non -violent breakdown in relationships.
- Top age group 36 59.

Working with Social Services Commissioning to review support services available in Powys. Need assertive/sticky support to deal with complex cases. Review of cases underway.

Concerns regarding managing poor behaviour in temporary accommodation and still maintaining COVID19 homeless duties.

Considering longer term strategy for households accommodated by reviewing Housing and Homeless strategies.

Request has been made for Powys County Council to be included in the Welsh Government Private Sector Leasing scheme pilot. PCC will need to consider purchasing additional accommodation and reconfiguring existing accommodation to accommodate the additional households.
