REPORT TITLE: Naming of the new school in the Banwy Valley

REPORT FOR: Decision

1. Purpose

- 1.1 Powys County Council (“the authority”) has proposed to close Banw Community Primary School and Llanerfyl Church in Wales Foundation School from August 2020, and establish a new Church in Wales Aided School with effect from September 2020.

2. Background

- 2.1 The name of the new school has been discussed by the pupils and staff of Banw Community Primary School and Llanerfyl Church in Wales Foundation School.

The communities were also part of the consultation process through the School Transformation Newsletter.

Following a discussion at the temporary governing body meeting on the 11th March 2020 it was agreed to propose Ysgol Cwm Banwy as the name of the new school.

3. Advice

- 3.1 It is proposed that the new school to open in September 2020 to replace Banw Community Primary School and Llanerfyl Church in Wales Foundation School be named as Ysgol Cwm Banwy.
