**REPORT FOR: Decision**

**1. Purpose**

- 1.1 Powys County Council (“the authority”) has decided to close Ysgol Uwchradd Caereinion and Llanfair Caereinion CP School from August 2022 and establish a new dual stream all age school with effect from September 2022.

**2. Background**

- 2.1 The name of the new school has been discussed by the pupils, staff and cluster primary schools of Ysgol Uwchradd Caereinion and Llanfair Caereinion CP School.

Following a discussion at the temporary governing body meeting of the new dual stream all age school on the 31<sup>st</sup> August 2021 it was agreed to propose Ysgol Bro Caereinion as the name of the new school.

**3. Advice**

- 3.1 It is proposed that the new school to open in September 2022 to replace Ysgol Uwchradd Caereinion and Llanfair Caereinion CP School be named as Ysgol Bro Caereinion.
