Many of them are struggling to get members, struggling to get clerks, and are restricted in their ability to operate in the interest of their communities. They also contribute towards council tax costs of Powys residents.</p> <p>County Councils have a responsibility to review town and community councils every 15 years. I believe that there is a need to do so in the interest of our residents. When will Powys County Council carry out such a review?</p>
