1. Purpose

- 1.1 To consider the Instrument of Government following a decision by the governing body of Brynhafren CP School on the 13th December 2023 to adopt an amended Instrument of Government. The current number of pupils on roll is 32.
- 1.2 The report contains a recommendation to ratify an amended Instrument of Government for Brynhafren CP School.

2.1 The Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005 required all school governing bodies to review and adopt revised Instrument of Government (Instruments of Government are the legal documents that detail the composition of a school governing body).

- 2 LA governors
- 1 teacher governor
- 0 staff governor
- 2 community governors
- 1 additional community governor (appointed by Bausley with Criggion Community Council) the headteacher

- 4 parent governors
- 3 LA governors
- 1 teacher governor
- 1 staff governor
- 3 community governors
- 1 additional community governor (appointed by Bausley with Criggion Community Council)

1. SCHOOL

2. CATEGORY OF SCHOOL

The school is a community school.

3. NAME OF GOVERNING BODY

The name of the Governing Body is Brynhafren C.P. School Governing Body.

4.0 COMPOSITION OF GOVERNING BODY

The governing body shall consist of:

- a) 4 parent governors
- b) 3 LA governors
- c) 1 teacher governor
- d) 1 staff governor
- e) 3 community governors
- f) 1 additional community governor appointed by Bausley with Criggion Community Council
- g) the headteacher (except at any time when he/she has given written notice to the clerk to the governing body of the school that he/she chooses not to be a governor).

5. TOTAL NUMBER

14 (except any time when the headteacher has given notice that he/she chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of governors will be 13).

6. DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION

Pursuant to regulation 37 of the Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005, this instrument of government comes into effect:

- (i) on the date of making for the purpose of reconstituting the governing body;
