Objection Representor Number 7 – Vehicles parked along the Cambrian Place highway too close to its junction with the Foundry Terrace highway would obstruct larger vehicles negotiating the narrow 90 degree bend at that location and interfere with the movements of larger vehicles entering or leaving the industrial site access at that location. It is considered that vehicles parked immediately in front of 10 Cambrian Place are less likely to interfere with such movements and therefore the extent of the waiting prohibitions at that location are shortened accordingly.

County Councillor Representation Number CC2 – Vehicles parked too close to the junction of Mount Lane with China Street interfere with the safe use of the uncontrolled pedestrian crossing point at that location and obstruct the movement of larger vehicles negotiating the Mount Lane/Smithfield Street/China Street junction. It is considered that a single vehicle parked along the east side of Mount Lane on the north side of the roadside tree within 5 metres of the said tree located between the properties Severn View and 10 Mount Lane would be less likely to interfere with such turning movements and therefore the extents of the waiting prohibitions at that location are shortened accordingly.

County Councillor Representation Number CC4 – Vehicles parked along either or both sides of Brook Street within a distance of 15 metres from the roundabout give way line would compromise the safe use of the roundabout.
