Response by the Cabinet Member:

Thank you of your questions,

For school project improvements concerning building heating efficiency, this type of project does not meet the eligibility criteria for UK Government Shared Prosperity Funding.

Any building heating efficiency project is funded centrally by the local authority as part of the capital programme and Invest to Save can be considered.

Alternatively, this financial year there is currently the Welsh Government Asset Collaboration Capital Grant which targets the reduction of electrical energy usage and other heating efficiency improvements in primary schools with adjoining community centres. The local authority will be submitting a funding bid for the limited capital funding of £250,000 to help reduce carbon emission, energy usage and costs.

The local authority is submitting a bid to the Welsh Government for SALIX funding which is an interest free loan to allow the funding of energy projects for example, LED lighting upgrades.
