a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

In making this application, we have taken into account the Guidance issued under the Licensing Act 2003. We have noted the effects of the Live Music Act 2005 upon this Premises Licence in its current format. We have inspected the premises and area and noted the environmental and socio-economic composition. We have also interrogated the Crime Mapper search engine on Police.co.uk As a consequence we are offering revised conditions which are proportionate, effective and enforceable and which will further promote the Licensing Objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- All staff shall be supervised and receive ongoing training to ensure compliance with the four Licensing Objectives. A Staff Induction and Training Log Book shall be maintained.
- 2. CCTV will be provided in the form of a recordable system, capable of providing images of evidential quality in all lighting conditions, particularly regarding facial recognition. Cameras must be maintained in good working order, cover all entrances, exits, outside areas and all areas where the sale/supply of alcohol occurs. Recordings should be date and time stamped, retained for a period of 31 calendar days, and made available to the Police or other 'Authorised Officer' under s13 of the Licensing Act 2003 on request.
- 3. The Designated Premises Supervisor will be an active member (at least 75% attendance of any meetings) of any local PubWatch or 'Bobb' Scheme for so as such a Scheme shall be in existence.

c) Public safety

- 4. A satisfactory NICEIC or ECA periodic electrical installation report will be provided. The inspection will be carried out at intervals stated by a qualified competent electrician (up to a period of five years and a new report on completion of each test will be provided).
- 5. A 30 milliamp residual current device protection will be provided to electrical sockets used for public entertainment equipment.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- 6. Prominent, clear and legible signage (not less than 32 font bold) shall be displayed at any entrance/exit and service counter hatch, requesting customers and members of the public respect local residents and leave the premises and area quickly and quietly.
- 7. When live amplified music events are taking place, a sound limiter shall be fitted and set to a level to be agreed with the Environmental Protection Officer(s) of Powys County Council.

e) The protection of children from harm

- 8. The premises shall operate a Challenge 25 Policy, which will be written down and kept at the premises. Prominent, clear and legible signage (not less than 32 font bold) shall be displayed, advertising and promoting that scheme & policy.
- 9. A Refusals Log Book and an ID Signature Log Book shall be maintained.
