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THE NATIONAL GRID TO GIVE A GRID REFERENCE CORRECT TO 100 METRES

EXAMPLE

The Grid Letters on this sheet are 91

EAST

Take west edge of kilometre square in which point lies and read the large figure printed opposite this line on north or south margin. Estimate tens Eastwards.

WEST

Take south edge of kilometre square in which point lies and read the large figure printed opposite this line on east or west margin. Estimate tens Westwards.

Full 100 Metres Reference SH 90063

The above Full Reference is unique. For many purposes the first grid letter can be omitted, giving a reference, SH 90063 which means an accuracy of 200 Metres. If both grid letters are omitted, the resulting reference, 063 means an accuracy of 100 Metres. When the area concerned is sufficiently restricted, as will usually be the case with maps on a scale of one inch to the mile and larger, both the grid letters are normally omitted.

At the Eastern edge of this sheet True North is 1.14 East of Grid North and at the Western edge 1.11 East of Grid North.

Magnetic North was about 3.1 West of Grid North in 1963 decreasing by about 1" in six years.

Gridlines are 100 metres apart. Mean Sea Level is Nilmetres.

Spot Heights and their values are shown thus: 504 100.2
