Mr Hughes has lived in the Pandy Rhiwsaeson area since childhood. His recollections in relation to the route now recorded as bridleway 6 and the surrounding area are as follows:

- His grandmother and then his father delivered the post in the area; his father was delivering the post by the time Mr Hughes was 5 or 6 years old. Mr Hughes accompanied his grandmother and his father delivering post on occasions.
- He was also involved in beating for the Wynnstay Estate shoot above Cwm Ffynnon as a child aged 9-10.
- Mr Hughes has not known use of the route now recorded as bridleway 6 by the general public.
- Mr Hughes does recollect using part of the route now recorded as footpath 7, when delivering the post with his father. He recalls walking up the path now recorded as footpath 11 from Cwm Gwyn to the county road, then along the county road and along the track to Cwm Ffynnon farm. They then walked down to Caeau-Gleision and then back across to the county road on the path now recorded as footpath 7. After that, they walked across open fields and joined the route now recorded as footpath 5 to Plas Rhiw-saeson.
- He recollects that there was a stile in the boundary between Cwm Ffynnon and Caeau-Gleision.
- Mr Hughes remembers walking with his ~~mother~~ <sup>father</sup>, a mule <sup>with his mother</sup> and the post up a cart track from road to Rhyd-y-Meirch and up past Esgair Gelynen. The start of the <sup>at what</sup> ~~was~~ <sup>a child</sup>

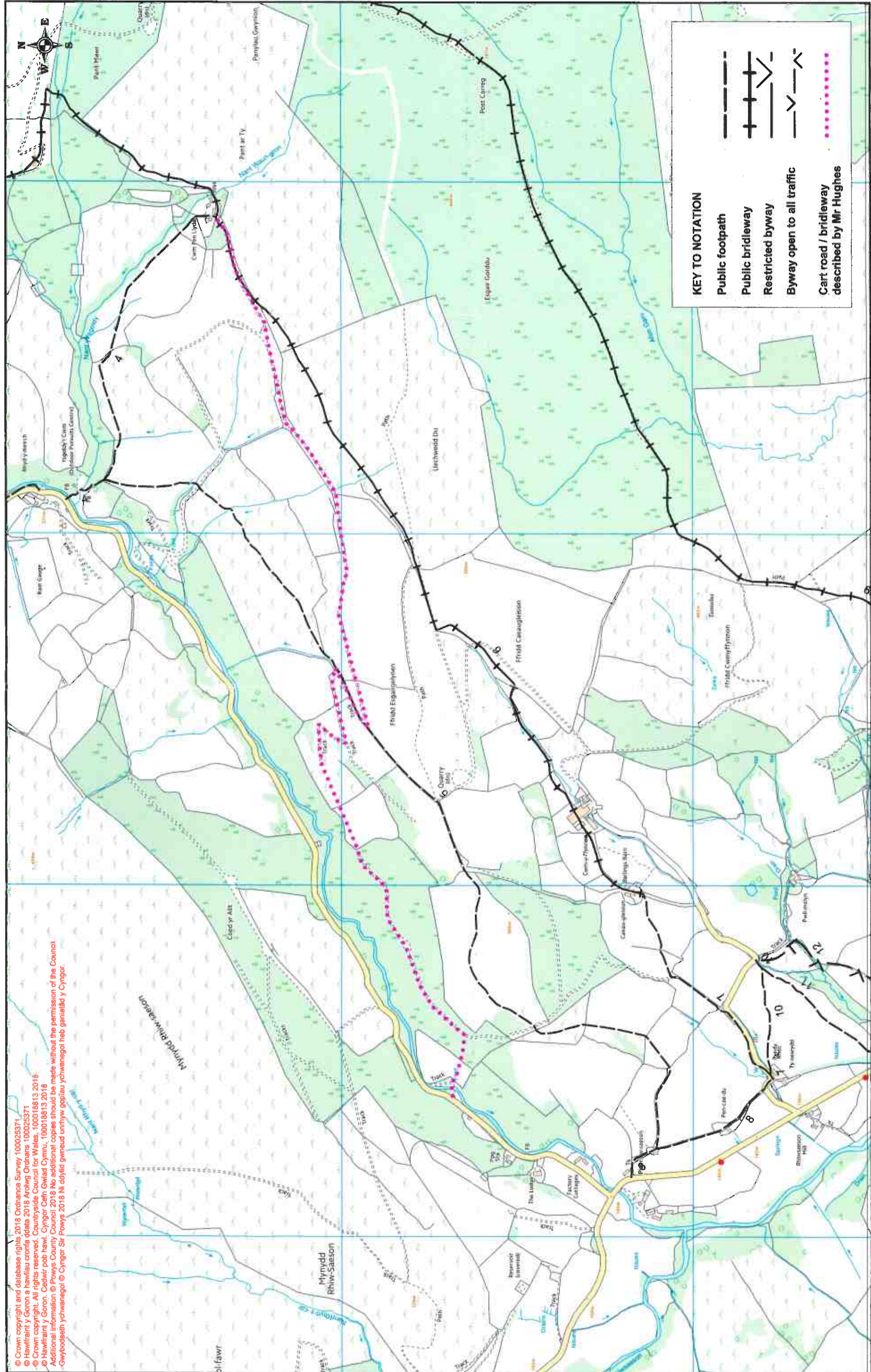
