This Order is made by Powys County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the path described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The Land Owner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the pathway into a fit condition for use by the public.


Ystradgynlais Community Council has been consulted.


BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Bryngroes and Penparc, Ystradgynlais, Powys and shown by a bold continuous black line on the plan contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order any statutory undertaker having apparatus affected by this Order shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely access at all reasonable times to maintain or repair statutory apparatus.
- 3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public bridleway over Bryngroes and Penparc, Ystradgynlais, described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold line with bars on the plan contained in this Order.
