The Learning and Skills Scrutiny Committee met on the 12-05-2021 and considered the following documents:

The Learning and Skills Scrutiny Committee thank the Portfolio Holder for Education and Property and officers for attending scrutiny.

Scrutiny make the following observations:

- The numbers of pupils moving between English Medium and Welsh Medium streams is currently anecdotal. The Cabinet should be provided with accurate figures for their consideration of the report.
- The Committee noted that there was nothing in the consultation response report which had not been addressed, or would be addressed in future. As this is a structured change to the language category at Ysgol Bro Hyddgen the Committee was satisfied that concerns raised in the consultation report would be addressed as the project progresses.
