Section 2: Constituency Activity

I have supported groups and individuals with the following issues:

- Highways – liaised between local residents and Powys County Council Highways Department regarding reconfiguration of roads and bus stop areas around Golwg y Cwm School.
- Dealt with various traffic issues including pavement bollards, various parking disputes (attempted mediation), the movement of the bus shelter, and street lighting issues.
- Expressed constituent's concerns over the deployment of the mobile Police Station in TESCO car park rather than Ystradgynlais centre.
- Facilitated bus route rescheduling and new timetables, routes, disabled access/raised kerbs, etc, negotiating with Powys Officers.
- Supported residents suffering rat infestations, high hedges and mediated neighbour disputes.
- Liaised between Senior Citizens and Environmental Agency regarding floodlighting of riverside work.
- Negotiated with Environmental Agency regarding the clearance of fallen trees in

River Tawe after a local resident expressed fears of flooding.

- Grass cutting – Liaised with Powys County Council Local Environmental Service Department over various grass cutting, hedge trimming, sewerage and gutter clearance matters.
- Penybryn/Aelybryn Estate – I dealt with various maintenance issues raised whilst on the Estates, for example repairs to external electricity and gas meter cupboards, clearance of 'rear' house footpaths and liaison with Estate Warden. I dealt with other relevant issues highlighted in regular discussion with Housing Maintenance Officer including environmental works such as repairs to fences and walls. I discussed Welsh Housing Quality Standard [WHQS] works and supported individuals with heating issues.
- On behalf of residents, I followed up the outstanding community works left after 'completion' of Golwg y Cwm CP School development.
- I met with Ystradgynlais Hospital Managers to discuss the Minor Injury Unit [MIU] and other health matters. This work is ongoing.

Section 3: Learning & Development - after the Elections in May 2012 induction sessions were provided during May and June to ensure that Councillors could undertake their roles. Ongoing monthly development is provided.

- Wedi hwyluso ad-drefnu amserlenni bysiau, amserlenni newydd, llwybrau, mynediad i'r anabl/ cyrbiau uwch, ac ati, gan drafod gyda Swyddogion Powys.
- Wedi cefnogi trigolion oedd yn dioddef oherwydd pla o lygod mawr, gwrychoedd uchel ac wedi cyfryngu mewn anghydfodau rhwng cymdogion.
- Wedi bod yn gyswllt rhwng Pensiynwyr ac Asiantaeth yr Amgylchedd ynghylch llifoleuo gwaith ar lannau'r afon.
- Wedi trafod gydag Asiantaeth yr Amgylchedd ynghylch clirio coed oedd wedi

chwmpo i AfonTawe ar ôl i un o'r trigolion lleol mynegi pryder ynghylch llifogydd.

- Torri glaswellt - wedi bod yn gyswllt gydag Adran Gwasanaethau Amgylcheddol lleol Cyngor Sir Powys ynghylch torri glaswellt, tocio gwrychoedd, problemau carthffosiaeth a chlirio cwteri.
- Ystâd Penybryn/Aelybryn - wedi delio gyda nifer o faterion cynnal a chadw ar yr Ystadau, er enghraifft, atgyweirio cypyrddau metrau trydan a nwy tu allan, clirio llwybrau yng nghefn y tai a bod yn gyswllt gyda Warden yr Ystâd. Rwyf wedi delio gyda phroblemau perthnasol eraill a nodwyd mewn trafodaethau rheolaidd gyda'r Swyddog Cynnal Tai, gan gynnwys gwaith amgylcheddol megis atgyweirio ffensys a waliau. Rwyf wedi trafod gwaith Safonau Ansawdd Tai Cymru [WHQS] ac wedi cefnogi unigolion gyda phroblemau gwresogi.
- Ar ran trigolion, rwyf wedi delio gyda gwaith cymunedol oedd yn weddill ar ôl 'cwblhau' Ysgol Golwg y Cwm.
