We refer to our letter of 11th May and thank you for the plan which you subsequently supplied. We have now clarified the position with our client Mr. Jones who has in fact now sold the property to Mr. R. L. Jukes. We return herewith a copy of the plan on which is marked edged in red the area in respect of which the registration of your Council and our client has apparently been registered. Our client now wishes to make it clear that the area in which he registered his right on the 29th June 1968 to graze 20 sheep and cut and take peat is that edged blue on the plan and he does claim ownership of that portion as well.

We felt it helpful to make the position clear from our client's point of view as we understand the Commissioners may in the future start determining these matters.
