### Section 2: Constituency activity

Over the last year, I have remained an active Councillor working hard for people across St John Ward and Brecon.

I hold regular advice surgeries at Brecon Library and weekly street surgeries across St John Ward, so that residents get the opportunity to talk to me about any concerns they have.

I have continued to manage a very busy caseload, representing local people and working hard to resolve their issues. I have worked with community organisations across the town to help improve the lives of St John Ward residents.

I held a special drop in session at Brecon Youth Centre for residents who wanted help with responding to the Council's consultation on its plans for Brecon High School. I hold regular *Cuppa with your Councillor* events where I meet with groups of residents to talk about community issues in a more informal setting and I join community volunteers on the first Sunday of each month to litter pick in St John Ward.

I deliver my ward newsletter *The Local Voice* to every house four times a year so that

constituents are kept up to date with my work as their local Councillor.

The last year has been very challenging for the Council and for my community. Continued austerity has allowed the Council to cut services which local people value and depend on. I have challenged the Council about its decisions and campaigned on behalf of St John Ward and Brecon to ensure the community I represent gets the best possible deal.

I have made progress on my campaign to secure the future of Brecon Market. The County Council has agreed to invest in a part time market manager post that the Town Council will oversee – creating a new partnership to secure the future of a local service. This is on top of EU funds being secured to undertake some survey work on the market site. The traders have formed a working group and I have joined their committee meetings to help and support their work.

I have made regular contributions to meetings and debates at County Hall. I have regularly asked questions of the Council's Cabinet, scrutinising their decisions and the impact on my community for example, I have used Council meetings to ask difficult questions about the Council's plans for secondary education on Brecon and the proposed cultural hub.

As a member of the Council's People Scrutiny Committee, I have led the work that looks at how the Council is improving Adult Social Care and its improvement plan following its failings in relation to Domiciliary Care. I have served as Vice Chair of the full People Scrutiny Committee.

Dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf, rwyf wedi parhau i fod yn Gynghorydd gweithgar gan weithio'n ddiwyd ar ran pobl Ward Sant Ioan ac Aberhonddu.

Rwy'n cynnal cymorthfeydd cyngori yn rheolaidd yn Llyfrgell Aberhonddu ac yn cynnal cymorthfeydd stryd bob wythnos ar draws Ward Sant Ioan, fel y gall trigolion gael y cyfle i siarad â mi am unrhyw bryderon sydd ganddynt.

Rwyf wedi parhau i reoli llwyth achosion prysur iawn, gan gynrychioli pobl leol a gweithio'n galed i ddatrys eu problemau. Rwyf wedi gweithio gyda mudiadau cymunedol ar draws y dref i helpu i wella bywydau trigolion Ward Sant Ioan.

Rwyf wedi cynnal sesiwn galw heibio arbennig yng Nghanolfan Ieuenctid Aberhonddu i

drigolion oedd eisiau helpu gydag ymateb i ymgynghoriad y Cyngor ar ei gynlluniau ar gyfer Ysgol Uwchradd Aberhonddu. Rwy'n cynnal digwyddiadau *Paned gyda'ch Cynghorydd* rheolaidd lle byddaf yn cwrdd â grwpiau o drigolion i siarad am faterion cymunedol mewn lle mwy anffurfiol ac rwy'n ymuno gyda gwirfoddolwyr cymunedol ar ddydd Sul cyntaf pob mis i godi sbwriel yn Ward Sant Ioan.

Rwy'n dosbarthu fy nghylchlythyr "Local Voice" i bob tŷ bedair gwaith y flwyddyn i ddiweddarau trigolion gyda'm gwaith fel eu Cynghorydd lleol.

Mae'r flwyddyn ddiwethaf wedi bod yn heriol iawn i'r Cyngor ac i'm cymuned. Mae cynni ariannol parhaus wedi caniatáu i'r Cyngor dorri gwasanaethau y mae pobl leol yn eu gwerthfawrogi ac yn dibynnu arnynt. Rwyf wedi herio'r Cyngor am ei benderfyniadau ac wedi ymgyrchu ar ran ward Sant Ioan ac Aberhonddu i sicrhau fod y gymuned a gynrychiolaf yn cael ei fargen orau posibl.

Rwyf wedi gwneud cynnydd ar fy ymgyrch i sicrhau dyfodol Marchnad Aberhonddu. Mae'r Cyngor Sir wedi cytuno i fuddsoddi mewn swydd rheolwr marchnad rhan amser y bydd Cyngor y Dref yn ei oruchwylio – gan greu partneriaeth newydd i sicrhau dyfodol gwasanaeth lleol. Rwyf wedi gwneud cyfraniadau rheolaidd i gyfarfodydd a thrafodaethau yn Neuadd y Sir. Rwyf wedi cyflwyno cwestiynau rheolaidd i Gabinet y Cyngor, wedi craffu ar eu penderfyniadau a'u heffaith ar fy nghymuned, er enghraifft, rwyf wedi defnyddio cyfarfodydd y Cyngor i ofyn cwestiynau anodd am gynlluniau'r Cyngor ar gyfer addysg uwchradd yn Aberhonddu a'r ganolfan ddiwylliannol arfaethedig.
