Sustainable Resource Strategy

- thanked everyone for producing a clear and concise document, which set a great example for how reports should be presented to Scrutiny Committees. It was easy to read and very comprehensive.
- noted that partnership collaboration was strong and able to heavily support the process and strategy.
- were pleased that comprehensive answers were received, and officers were open and willing to explore points raised that could benefit the strategy.
- it was acknowledged that significant service improvement had been introduced to support the reduction of missed collections.
- would encourage residents to be part of the twelve-week engagement process if approved by Cabinet.
